


How Many Processors Are Available?

The APLNextSupervisor v0.9.25.x version implements an 'NProcessors' property which will return an integer vector containing the number of physical and virtual processors of the workstation on which the APLNextSupervisor has been installed. This information can be used to configure the APLNextSupervisor 'minpool' and 'maxpool' properties under program control. For example, the result '1 4' below indicates that there is one physical processor and four virtual processors on this particular machine.
